

Additional information about the arrival and registration procedure will be posted under Competition info.

The procedure when arriving at the Event Centre (the Event Centre will be open from 12:00 on 20.08 till 18:00 on 23.08.):

1. Participants arriving with own vehicle shall fill out a Safety Declaration form and submit it to an Agent appointed by the Organiser. Alternatively, you can print out and sign the form in advance and submit it to the Agent upon arrival. The Safety Declaration form will be posted on the website under Competition info.
2. The organiser's Agent will examine the facts indicated in the Declaration. Participants stating that within the past 14 days they have visited or stayed in the „yellow” or „red” countries, hereinafter described as „subject to self-isolation”, Unless the participant subject to self-isolation is able to provide the required negative test result from Latvia, he/she will be directed to a mobile COVID-19 testing station located at the Event Centre. The cost is EUR 59 per test. The mobile testing station working hours will be from 12:00 till 17:00 on 20.08 and from 10:00 till 15:00 on 21.08.
3. Participants subject to self-isolation will have a dedicated area for building tents and awaiting the COVID-19 test result.
4. The dedicated area will be accommodated with toilets, hand washing equipment and disinfectant agents, drinking water, place for independent cooking (on own cookers). Also, it will be possible to order delivery of meals. The menu and price-list will be published one week before the competition.
5. Participants subject to self-isolation rules may appear at the Event Centre and perform any competition-related actions only when wearing a face mask or any other makeshift cover on his/her mouth and nose (e.g. a buff or bandana).
6. All participants when doing their registration routines or approaching the information centre are obliged to wear a face mask or any other makeshift cover on his/her mouth and nose.
7. All participants at registration should present a personal ID and submit an “Indemnity Form” signed by all members of the team. The “Indemnity Form” can be printed out and signed in advance (accessible on the website www.erc2020.lv under Competition info), or filled out at the Event Centre.
8. Participants other than those subject to self-isolation will be directed to the Event Centre area indicated by the Organisers.

The list of „yellow” and „red” countries is compiled by the Latvian Centre for Disease Prevention and Control. It is updated on a weekly basis on Fridays and takes effect starting Saturday. As to the ERC2020, the binding list will be the one approved on 14 August.
